Sadly, there was no one with the new hero only two nights later when the twenty-four-year-old's life came to an abrupt end in a barren, desolate place only an hour from the site of his greatest achievement as a professional athlete.

one will ever know Marshawn's final thoughts. Perhaps, they were of his beloved mother, Wendy, who died unexpectedly in February of 2024.

He was extremely well-liked by those who knew him, played with him and coached him. The Dallas Cowboys have pledged to financially support Marshawn Kneeland's family for the remainder of their lives.

WHEN TO FILE FOR SOCIAL Security



hen a person reaches the age of sixty-two, they are eligible to start receiving monthly Social Security payments, While receiving benefits at that age can be attractive, you should be aware that the amount of money received from the government will be higher each year that you wait. If you can afford it, do not request the monthly benefits until you reach the age of seventy. Social Security is a lifetime monthly payment program started during the administration of President Franklin D. Roosevelt.

It is designed to give Americans a financial cushion once they are no longer a part of the workforce. Less than ten percent of the country's eligible population waits until they reach seventy to claim their benefits.

The longer you delay receiving your benefits, the more you will receive each month!

f you are the spouse of a deceased person who was receiving Social Security payments, you should notify the Social Security Administration. In some cases, you will be eligible to receive a portion of the deceased person's benefits.

If you have questions about benefits you can reach the Social Security Administration at 1 800 772 1213. Their site address is www.ssa.gov. |AR




